5 key elements of the Reggio Emilia approach to early ...

‘élite’, definition of creativity. Howard Gardner (6), adopts an élite definition of creativity when he argues that truly creative people are those who make a difference to the world (e.g. by moving forward thinking in science, social science, music or art). This type of ‘Big C’ creativity is reserved for very few individuals.
