Therefore sale or purchase of fixed asset in accounting perspective is NOT same as sale or purchase of inventory. Inventory is such asset that is bought with an intention to sell. Whereas other assets are bought with an intention to use which most of the time helps in converting inventory to finished goods.

Recommend to management any updates to accounting policies related to fixed assets. Assign tag numbers to fixed assets. Record fixed asset acquisitions and dispositions in the accounting system. Track the compilation of project costs into fixed asset accounts, and close out those accounts once the related projects have been completed.
