The first step is to loosen the locknut and adjuster nut slightly.

Manual Clutch Adjustment. First, turn off the engine and engage the emergency brake. Position yourself so your head is partly underneath the dashboard, allowing you to see and access any adjustments that need to be made. Your vehicle will most likely have a clutch cable with a threaded rod. The rod will have a locknut and an adjuster nut to determine the amount of free play the clutch pedal has.

Wedge the clutch pedal in the fully raised position with a block of wood. Locate the clutch cable and find where the outer cable is seated against its cable stop on the edge of the bell housing. The locknut and the adjuster nut are at the end of the outer cable, next to the cable stop.

Manual Adjustment. To start a manual pedal adjustment, the engine first needs to be turned off. Make sure the emergency brake is activated. When you sit in the front seat, you'll want to position your head so that you can see a little bit under the dashboard. Next, push the clutch pedal down with one of your hands until it's near the floorboard. Hold this position. Search the clutch structure for a big hook-like component.

### **Troubleshooting the Clutch on a Manual Transmission ...**

Your first step in adjusting a hydraulic clutch is to locate the slave-cylinder pushrod and determine if it is adjustable or not. The only way to adjust a hydraulic clutch is by adjusting the length of the slave-cylinder pushrod. If your pushrod is not adjustable, you may be able to find a suitable replacement at a junkyard that you can install.

With the clutch pedal against stop: loosen jam nuts sufficiently to allow the adjusting rod to move against the clutch fork until release bearing contacts the pressure plate fingers lightly. Rotate upper nut (B) against swivel and back off 4-1/2 turns. Tighten lower nut (A) to lock swivel against nut (B).

Using this method to adjust the clutch is actually the number one cause of poor-release issues. A quick down-and-dirty way to check for clutch release is to simply get the car good and warm so all components are heated and expanded. Press down on the clutch pedal and count to 10. Within 10 seconds the transmission should slow on its own.

### **Manual Transmission Clutch Basics - Muscle Car DIY**

Inspect the adjustment on the linkage before condemning the clutch. Look for the arm coming out of the transmission bellhousing on the left driver's side. The linkage can be seen running alongside the transmission used to push on this arm. This is called the throw out bearing release arm.
