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### Rules For The Dance A

Just as dancing is "the art of moving in accord with a pattern," says Mary Oliver, so is writing metrical verse. "One sorts out the pattern, one relies on it, and relaxes from effort to pleasure." The rules (concerning rhyme, line length, and pattern) are made if not to be deliberately flouted, then at

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least to be toyed with.

Rules of the Dance is a lesson in writing with rhythm and rhyme, even meter in non-metric verse. The last 80 pages are an anthology of the poems she used to teach in the first 107 pages. Example: Mary teaches metrical patterns and their symbols (iamb, trochee, dactyl, and anapest (two light stresses followed by a heavy stress)).

One performer is allowed to make solo dance in more than one competitions. In one competition, the solo performer is not allowed to repeat the same style twice. Ballet routines should not contain acrobatic styles. In a competition, the performer is allowed to dance on two lyrical solos.

Respect the dance space. Pick up trash, your clothes, and don't turn things on, off, up, or down in the space without permission. Watch your language, even when you mess up. Don't "hang" or slouch on the barre or anywhere else, for that matter.

## **38 Must-Know Dance Class Rules**

Inappropriate dress or behavior will not be allowed. No gum, food or drinks will be permitted inside the classrooms during class or rehearsal. Rules For Dancers. Individual Dancer: The dancer must keep dancing throughout the competition.

Try your best. If you make the mistake of taking a dance class that's above your skill level, never walk out of a class or sit down in frustration—hang in there and try your best, no one will fault you for that. Be courteous and respectful. At the end of class, applaud and thank the instructor.

Formations / Transitions (Max 10 points) - Make sure you travel / transition with intent making full use of space. Keep placement & formations neat & tight.
