## **Stormwater Construction Design Guidelines - New York City**

## **Stormwater Management - Maryland**

The Queensland Urban Drainage Manual (QUDM) shall be the basis for design of stormwater drainage except where amended by this Guideline. The engineer shall ensure that Council's requirements relating to stormwater quality management, erosion and sediment control and acid sulphate soils are provided for in the stormwater design.

## **New development, redevelopment ... - City of Lexington**

The design techniques in this section are meant to maximize the volume of stormwater being infiltrated. If the site layout and underlying soil conditions permit, a portion of the Channel Protection Volume (V<sub>cp</sub>), Overbank Flood Protection Volume (V<sub>p10</sub>), and the Extreme Flood Volume (V<sub>p100</sub>) may also be managed in the infiltration practice.

## **Water management: policies, guidelines, provincial water ...**

The Construction General Permit TXR150000 requires the City of Bryan to adopt a Stormwater Management Plan (SWMP) and submit an annual compliance report to TCEQ. The plan addresses how the City of Bryan handles pollution prevention, construction site stormwater runoff control, and post-construction stormwater management.

## **Development Regulations and Guidelines - City of Bryan, Texas**

When stormwater drains off a construction site, it carries sediment and other pollutants that can harm lakes, streams, and wetlands. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency estimates that 20 to 150 tons of soil per acre are lost every year to stormwater runoff from construction sites.

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
