Tone Lowry uses direct, simple language with very few figures of speech or ironic comments (though Jonas and the Giver make ironic statements.)

The simplicity of the language is appropriate for Lowry's audience, children between eleven and fifteen, but it also echoes the "precision of language" demanded by Jonas's community.
