The Screen resolution is generally measured as width x height in pixels. For example resolution 1920 x 1080 means the 1920 pixels is width and 1080 pixels is height of the screen. What resolution should I set my monitor to?

On PC - Right-mouse click on your desktop and select "Properties". Next, select the "Settings" tab. You will be brought to a frame that shows your current display resolution (ex: 1024x7868). Drag the "Screen Resolution" slider left to make your desktop resolution smaller and drag the "Screen Resolution" slider right to make it bigger.

How do I check or change my computer's Display/Screen ...

Use the drop-down menu or slider next to Resolution (XP calls it Screen Resolution) to pick a different resolution setting. In most circumstances, the best choice is 800 by 600 pixels or 1024 by 768 pixels, possibly higher if you're using a 19-inch or larger monitor.

How to Adjust the Screen Resolution Setting in Windows

Most devices will support any resolution and refresh rate up to the maximum value listed. To find the resolutions supported by your computer and display, check with those specific manufacturers. If you are using multiple displays in clone or duplicate mode, you can only select a resolution supported by all displays.
